

Information about our Services

In Our 8.30 am Sunday services appeal to those who enjoy a quiet space to worship. On the first and third Sundays of the month we celebrate Holy Communion and on the second and fourth Sundays we say Morning Prayer. A cuppa is on offer before heading for home.

Our 10.00 am Sunday Services are more family orientated and include hymns and contemporary worship songs:

- on the first Sunday of each month our Family Service is designed *especially* with children in mind – just half an hour, short prayers, hymns with actions and instead of a sermon there is an Open the Book* type story. Children are, of course welcome at all our services but our Family Service provides an opportunity for mums and dads to relax, knowing the children can be noisy and are free to wander around.
- on the third Sunday of the month we say Morning Prayer or enjoy alternative worship
- on the second and fourth Sundays we celebrate Holy Communion

At the end of the services the congregation decants into the church hall for refreshments and further fellowship

Our Evening Worship with Healing Service at 6.00 pm on the first Sunday of each month provides the chance to simply sit and be quiet; it is very informal, with guitar-led worship songs and the opportunity to receive a healing blessing.
